#### Client

A major East Coast hospital sought to reduce its environmental footprint while maintaining strict hygiene standards. Their reliance on traditional paper-based and plastic food service disposables was leading to excessive waste and unsustainable purchasing costs. To meet their corporate sustainability goals and ensure compliance with new regulations, they needed a partner with expertise in sustainable, cost-effective solutions.







## Background

This large healthcare provider operates multiple hospital campuses, serving thousands of patients, staff, and visitors daily. Their food service operations consumed significant amounts of single-use cups, plates, utensils, and paper products.

With increasing pressure from internal stakeholders and state legislation pushing for sustainability, the hospital sought to transition to eco-friendly alternatives without compromising operational efficiency or incurring additional costs.





### Background

Key challenges included:

- Reducing reliance on plastic-based and tree-based disposables.
- Meeting sustainability targets while keeping costs manageable.
- Ensuring compostable alternatives worked within their existing waste management systems.
- Educating staff on the facts of renewable material from inception to recovery and training all on proper disposal of compostable products.





#### Solution

Along with the hospital's service provider, Emerald Ecovations worked closely with the hospital's facilities and food service teams to implement a tailored sustainability program:

- Tree-Free & Plastic-Free Products: We replaced traditional single-use plastics and paper disposables with compostable alternatives made from rapidly renewable fibers.
- Cradle-to-Cradle Composting Integration: Our team collaborated with the hospital's waste management provider to ensure proper sorting and composting of disposables, reducing landfill waste.





#### Results

57% reduction in plastic waste from food service disposables.

\$270,000 in annual cost savings by switching to tree-free solutions and reducing waste disposal fees.

Staff engagement improved, with 85% reporting increased awareness of sustainable practices in post-training surveys.
